

## PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

## START EYE DROPS 2 DAYS BEFORE SURGERY Including morning of surgery

Contact Lens Instructions for cataract surgery patients only: Soft Contact Lenses must be out 1 week prior to **pre-op** (**measurements**) visit Hard / Gas Permeable Contact Lenses must be out 3 weeks prior to **pre-op** visit

## **SURGERY INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Please be sure a responsible adult is with you to escort and drive you home after surgery. THIS IS THE SURGERY CENTER POLICY
- 2. Do not eat or drink anything after midnight (or as instructed by your physician or nurse).
- 3. Medicines related to the heart, high blood pressure, and acid reflux should be taken the morning of surgery with sip of water.
- 4. DO NOT STOP blood thinners (aspirin, coumadin, plavix, efficit, pradaxa) unless advised.
- 5. Please bring all medications to the surgery center on the day of surgery.
- 6. If you are diabetic, do not give yourself the insulin. Bring insulin / pills with you.
- 7. Remove all make-up, jewelry and nail polish.
- 8. Dress comfortably (i.e. button-down shirt).
- 9. Do not bring valuables.
